Respect and protection of religious freedom is the main policy of the Chinese Government. Freedom of religion is considered as a fundamental right of citizens, protected by the Constitution and the law. The choice of religion is a private matter of a citizen. The Constitution, legal laws and State policy guarantee religious freedom of conscience to every citizen and grant him freedom of choice. The laws of China, in addition to guaranteeing the freedom of religion of citizens, emphasize their duties. In China, any person, any organization and any religion must defend the interests of the people, protect the dignity of the law, national cohesion and the unity of the state. No one is allowed to violate public order under the pretext of performing religious rituals, to endanger the lives of citizens.</p> <p>Constitutional law of the People's Republic of China-The Constitutional law of the People's Republic of China is characterized by significant features: its content and ways of development are still greatly influenced by tradition; many fundamental social relations are regulated by acts of the ruling Communist Party of China (CPC); has a clearly expressed ideological character; reflects the modern contradiction between the economic and political systems of Chinese society; characterized by an abundance of norms-proclamations, norms-edification, etc. p./ Penal Enforcement law of the People's Republic of China- China is a variant of a mixed model of the organization of the system of execution of punishments and detention in pre-trial detention, since the functions of the management of institutions in which convicts are held are divided between different ministries: the competence of the Ministry of Justice includes management</p> <p>The penitentiary obligation of the Ministry of Internal Affairs is the detention of persons in custody at the stage of preliminary investigation and trial. According to the Chinese penal enforcement doctrine, the execution of punishment in prison, first of all, is the implementation of the principle of non-compliance with the criminal element. Retribution is comparable to reeducation, in retribution the main attention is paid to coercion, in reeducation the main attention is paid to turning the criminal to another side, facing society. The purpose of retaliation, as noted by the Chinese authors- penitentiaries— to re-educate the criminal, to make him a law-abiding citizen, while the Chinese penal legislation considers the principle of combining re-education with labor.</p>

	<p>of the People's Republic of China of 1986 have not lost their force and are applied in the part that does not contradict the law of 2017. In addition to the 1986 law, laws regulating certain types of civil legal relations (special laws) continue to be applied. The codification of the civil law of the People's Republic of China will be completed by the development and adoption of the Civil Code. This significant event should take place in 2020. The main provisions of the civil law of the People's Republic of China in 2017 will acquire the meaning of the General Part in the structure of such a code. The heirs of the General Provisions of the Civil Law of the People's Republic of China in 1986 and some special laws will be the remaining parts of the future code.</p> <p>History of the state and law of China—within the framework of this discipline, the main provisions of the state and law of China will be studied, starting from the period of Ancient China, the Qing Empire, the Republic of China (1912-1949), the PRC (from 1949 to the present), including the period of the "great leap" and the "cultural revolution"/Human rights and the mechanism of their protection— This is a system established and guaranteed by law to ensure the legal status of an individual, which includes the orderly activities of public authorities, non-governmental human rights organizations and the independent implementation of subjective rights and freedoms aimed at preventing, suppressing and restoring violated rights and freedoms while maintaining an appropriate balance of public and private interests.</p>
